	If COVID Positive	Symptoms Present AND Non-COVID Diagnosis from Medical Provider	Please inform school of exposure.	Classroom families will be informed. The class will remain in session.
<b>RETURN TO SCHOOL WHEN:</b>	<p><b>All</b> four criteria have been met:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. At least 24 hours fever free without fever-reducing medication</li> <li>2. At least 5 days of isolation have passed since symptoms first appeared</li> <li>3. Symptom free</li> <li>4. COVID Negative PCR test</li> </ol>	<p><b>All</b> three criteria have been met:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. At least 24 hours fever free without fever-reducing medication</li> <li>2. At least 24 hours symptom free</li> <li>3. Note from Doctor or Medical Provider</li> </ol>	<p>Vaccinated or unvaccinated, after 5 days of quarantine <b>AND</b> symptom free.</p>	<p>Vaccinated or unvaccinated, after voluntary quarantine <b>AND</b> symptom free.</p>
	<p><b>Keep student home if ANY</b> of the following symptoms are present and are not typical for the student: Fever of 100.0 or higher, cough, congestion/runny nose, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, sore throat, vomiting, abdominal symptoms, diarrhea, new skin conditions, new loss of taste or smell, fatigue, headache, neck pain</p> <p><b>Students will be sent home if symptoms develop at school</b></p>		<p>A student exposed to a person living in their home, who has a COVID positive test, must quarantine.</p>	<p>Students in a classroom with a COVID positive case, may quarantine, if family chooses.</p>
